Thank-you Lord, for what You are doing to make me free from my own sin and the sins of others.

Pray that prayer in your own words, in your own way, and allow the **Holy Spirit** to make you free. You know you are free when you can remember what happened but not hold it against anyone anymore.

Be free!

Live free!

Now and forever more.

If the unforgiveness is set deep within you it will take a constant and continual effort to allow this to happen.

We must forgive until God has taken the unforgiveness from us and we have truly and completely forgiven.

This applies to any and all who have offended you. Parents, relatives, friends, associates, anyone that you have ill feelings toward.

The results of such forgiveness are amazing.

Try it you will like it, I guarantee it! And so does Father God, Son Jesus, and the Holy Spirit!
