2017 Mariners

In May 2017, Mariners got reestablished as a group to distribute current funds in the Mariners account. To do so, the group elected officers to oversee such transactions. Officers include **Jay Irizarry** and **Kay Qualls** to serve as Co-Presidents, **Pat Benton** as Secretary, and **Patty Shafer** as Treasurer. **Don Benton** ran this meeting. The current budget in May was \$1,172.71.

In June, it was discussed, voted and approved to donate \$200.00 to the **Village Christian Fellowship** church for backpacks during the **National Neighborhood Night Out**. **Shower Bus** also received an offering.

Not much to report on in July and August. Jay ran the meeting in July, while Kay called the meeting in August. Budget was at \$1,037.71.

In September, the budget report remain the same. The group discussed, voted and approved to donate \$500.00 to the **Disaster Relief Fund** and also their volunteers.

October was a longer meeting. Budget balance was at \$1,117.71 which included September's offering. The group had two things to discuss. First, it was voted and approved donating \$200.00 to two students who were affected by the fire in Santa Rosa. Then the group discussed donating to the Fire Dept. for toys and food, which will be determined in the November meeting.

In November, budget balance sat at \$407.71. The group voted and approved donating \$200.00 to the fire dept. Kay brought up having a Christmas party for the December meeting, where it will be a potluck with a \$5.00 gift exchange.

I want to thank everyone for their time setting up the meals and participating in our meetings as well as donating to our budget. I also want to thank our Mariners officers who go above the call of duty to help organize our budget. A special thank you goes out to those who have been involved in creating devotions each month and Kathy Price for organizing the devotions list. I feel like we have all done a lot the last six months, and I am excited to see what we can do moving forward.
