## THE LORD'S PRAYER

The Lord's Prayer is our guide to an effective prayer life. It contains the formula for communication with God the Father. Our Father: calls us to family and the closeness we should have with the Lord God Almighty. Who are in heaven: tells us His domain. Hollowed is Thy name: signifies the Holiness of God. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven: giving God the authority on earth that He has in His heavenly kingdom. Give us this day our daily bread: lifts our needs up to God and acknowledges that He is the supplier of our needs on a daily basis. And forgive us our debts as we forgive our debors: as we are generous, God is generous unto us. Lead us not into temptation: help us to walk away from that which tempts us. But deliver us from evil: asking for God's protection from the evil one. For Thine is the Kingdom, the Power, and the Glory, forever: acknowledgment of the fact that God is in control of all things. Amen: let this come to be, it is our wish that this happens.

Use the Lord's Prayer to guide your prayer time. First claiming **Him** as the intimate, hands on **Father** of our eternal family. Then acknowledging **His kingdom** as the **eternal kingdom** to which we belong now and forever. Then acknowledge **Him** as the **Holy One**. Next is the acknowledgment that His kingdom is **the Kingdom** and should be so on earth as it is in fact in heaven. Then **come before Him** with your needs knowing that **He will meet them** in **His time** and **His way**. Next we **join Him** in **His goodness** and generosity, giving and forgiving as He does. Then we ask Him to help us defeat the enemy who comes to destroy. And we end with the proclamation of His greatness, superiority and glory.

So have fun with it, like: Holy Heavenly Daddy, may your control extend to earth as it is in heaven. Take care of my needs, in your time and in your way, I trust you completely to meet my needs. Forgive me my shortcomings as I forgive the shortcomings of others. Help me to overcome evil in and around me, in and through me. You, and in you, is the Kingdom, the Power, and the Glory now and forever more. Amen

Or: Our Father in heaven, let Your name be holy, let Your kingdom come, and let Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For the kingdom and the power and the glory belong to You! Amen.

You can spend as much time as you want or need in each section. Acknowledging God, giving your needs to God, partnering with God, depending on God, asking for His help and proclaiming His glory. The important thing is that it leads you to cover all aspects of life as you pray through the Lord's Prayer. *Enjoy your time with Him.*
