 - He came to lift our fading hopes in the coming of the Messiah.

- 5. To reveal Eternal Truths. John 14-17. John 14:16-17.

 - How do you forgive those who have wronged you?




And the only question to really ask at that point was whether it was the FIRST time Eli had done that to the cat's behind or the hundredth.
