# **KNOWING A FAITHFUL GOD**

Thoughts inspired by David Jeremiah

#### God is the apex of all reality.

God's faithfulness is the **core** of integrity; it is the glue that holds society together. Look at Psalm 89:2 and Genesis 8:22: *God promises that He is with us and life will go on*.

Great is Thy Faithfulness. **God can be trusted**. Isaiah 11:5: He **is** and **will always be** faithful though mankind is unfaithful to Him and each other many times and in many ways.

Numbers 23:19 shows just how **faithful** God is. Psalm 119:90 uses the word which we translate **Amen** which means *so it is, so let it be*. Faithfulness is keeping one's word: Joshua 23:14. God will always do what He says: Deuteronomy 7:9.

The attributes of God effect us now. His faithfulness precludes worry. Hebrews 10:23: For God is faithful to his promises. Jesus is God's faithful witness. Revelation 22:6: The Bible is faithful and true words. The promises of God are faithful and true. Psalm 119:89-90: **Trust God and relax**; trusting Him to fulfill his promises concerning you. God's faithfulness promises answers. Psalm 143:1 and Jeremiah 33:3: When God prompts you to pray-**PRAY**.

God's faithfulness protects us from evil. 2 Thessalonians 3:3: The **Lord's Prayer** guides us away from evil and the evil one. God's faithfulness is unconditional – not dependent on us. God's faithfulness promotes praise. Psalm 89:1-8: Praise God from whom all . . . Praise is our response to His faithfulness. Psalm 71:22: We need God's protection in and over our lives. Until we praise God we are not enjoying Him and until we learn how to worship God we are leaving the blessings of God on the table. Psalm 92:1-2: God's faithfulness provides encouragement to us. The prophet Jeremiah knew discouragement. He lived in the final days of Judah and Jerusalem and was taken in bondage. Lamentations 1:1-2: All is lost. The promises of God seem lost forever. However, the promises of God will be fulfilled. Lamentations 3:16-18: All hope is gone – **NO**! Lamentations 3:21-23: God will be faithful. All believers must trust God and believe He will do what He has promised. Stop listening to yourself complain and start talking to yourself remembering God's continuing compassions are new each morning. Tell yourself that **God is our portion**. Therefore I will **trust in Him**. God is faithful because it is His nature. Believe first, trust first, not by what you see but because of what we know about God. Man might not be faithful, but God is and always will be. As Thou has been, Thou forever will be. God is waiting for us, for His faithfulness endures forever. *Take His hand and allow Him to lead you to the full life he has planned for you, now and forever*.

#### POSITIVE THINKING INSIGHTS

A major league baseball pitcher once pitched a game in Kansas City on an afternoon when the temperature was 105 degrees in the shade. Halfway through the game, he suddenly felt weak, listless, too washed out to continue.

But this ball player was a creative, practical Christian, so he walked to the pitcher's mound for a moment, repeating to himself a scripture from the fortieth chapter of **Isaiah**: "But those who trust the Lord will find strength. They will be strong like eagles soaring upward on wings; they will walk and run without getting tired."

He finished the game with energy to spare and reported that he never had a better time in his life with more feelig of mastery in that game. This Christian discovered a great truth: the power of God is not only concerned with ethical precepts or with sociological and theological matters, but in a deep sense it has to do with recreation of the believer.

Positive Thinking Insight – If you want your situation to be different, perhaps the answer is to become different yourself. Tremendous things happen to the believer. So believe the answer will come. It will.

Our life is always deeper than we know, is always more divine than it seems, and hence we are able to survive degradations and despairs which otherwise must engulf us.
