

Especially during the holidays people feel inspired to donate to the various organizations collecting food and other items to share with those who find themselves in need.

Most people buy what they think food pantry users want, but have never actually asked them. If you help families, single people, foster youth and the homeless, this list can help better tailor your donations! Here are some tips and guidance if you want to donate to food pantries that come from feedback by those who use them:

- 1. Everyone donates Kraft Mac and Cheese in the box. However, it needs milk and butter which is hard to get from regular food banks.
- 2. Boxed milk is a treasure, as kids need it for cereal which they also get a lot of.
- 3. Everyone donates pasta sauce and spaghetti noodles.
- 4. They cannot eat all the awesome canned veggies, tuna or soup unless you put a can opener in too or buy pop tops.
- 5. Oil is a luxury but needed for Rice a-Roni which they also get a lot of.
- 6. Spices or salt and pepper would be a real Christmas gift.
- 7. Tea bags and coffee make them feel like you care.
- 8. Sugar and flour are treats.
- 9. They fawn over fresh produce donated by farmers and grocery stores.
- 10. Seeds are cool in Spring and Summer because growing can be easy for some.
