

Meditation on Psalm 63: 1-8

Taken from Living Word Bulletin Series March 23, 2025

³Because Your lovingkindness is better than life,
 My lips shall praise You.
 ⁴ Thus I will bless You while I live;
 I will lift up my hands in Your name.
 ⁵ My soul shall be satisfied as with a rich feast,
 And my mouth shall praise You with joyful lips.

As a momma of toddlers, I often experienced the clinging arms of a small child wrapped around my leg. It happened in good times, with laugher; scary times, with tears; when feeling shy or needing the assurance of familiarity; or simply resting in the comfort of my presence. Those little arms held tightly, fiercely, with all their might—the purpose clear: I am staying attached to momma.

I want to be like that with God. To be filled with longing and to know true gut thirst for the living water that is only God's to give. I want to affirm with my whole being that God is the only true source of my contentment and satisfaction.

Psalm 63 is not written about God; is spoken directly to God. The words are not "platitudes of gratitude" for when things are going great and one feels the obligation to remember God. Instead, these words, spoken when times were tough for David, are a confession of affirmation recognizing his all-consuming need for God and then declaring God's faithfulness in filling that need with abundance.

I want my lips to be joyful and my hands to rise in heartfelt praise to the One whose lovingkindness I know is better than life itself. Whether in good times or scary times, when needing assurance and comfort or simply a rest from the weariness of my days, I want to cry out like the Psalmist:

Oh God, You. Are. My. God!

My soul longs for you...desires you...thirsts for you. For You, o God alone, can satisfy the visceral need of my soul.

From the shadow of your wings, tucked in and clinging tightly with all my might,

I will praise You and rejoice.
