



Historically, within the Church of the Brethren, most congregations had some kind of an organized group for women to participate in



- Organizing the Sunday Coffee Hours and lunches and providing the needed kitchen supplies
- Praying for the folks who make up our congregation
- Providing both encouraging and decorative touches to the fellowship hall and other spots around the building
- Putting together and delivering "goodie trays" to shut-ins, older members, single men and church staff at Christmas.
- Meeting together monthly for fellowship and working on the active projects
- Making blankets for kids that are given to the Modesto Children's Crisis Center for distribution Heaven's Bounty Thrift Shop, open just once a month on the first Saturday from 9am-2pm, is an ongoing project. In addition to the actual sale day, it requires a minimum of one work day, plus all the smaller amounts of time various folks put in throughout the month to make it successful. From the sale proceeds, a check for \$150 is written each month to the organizations listed below. Larger contributions go to church projects like tree cutting and carpet cleaning, along with additional monies sent in response to recent flood, fire and hurricane disaster needs.
